

2012 High School Baseball Bat Rules and Regulations



Beginning January 1, 2012, the NFHS (National Federation of State High School Associations) has ruled that all baseball bats used in high school play be BBCOR certified. The

NCAA made this change for their 2011 season.

According to a NFHS press release, “all non-wood bats must be labeled with a rectangular certification mark a minimum of a half-inch on each side and located on the barrel of the bat in any contrasting color.” You can see an example of the logo in the top left corner of this post. Wooden bats are not affected by this rule. They are still legal. BESR bats will no longer be legal for high school play.
